Hack-Working Stock Horse-Time Trial – Utility Pattern

This event is organized by the South West Branch of The Australian Stock Horse Society.

Horses <u>do not</u> have to be registered Australian Stock Horses; they may be any breed.

Temporary membership is available for non ASHS -members for this event. For competition days like this the temp membership is \$50 for adults and \$20 for riders under 18 Years.

You are welcome to camp over Friday night and Saturday night. You may arrive any time from 3:00pm onwards. Please advise Lance if you are camping as he needs to make sure the clubrooms are open for you to access toilet, showers and kitchen. There is a small charge for camping.

Please make yourself known at the office (clubhouse verandah) on the Saturday morning from 7:30 on. There will be a "Jobs List" on a whiteboard, all those little jobs that need doing to make the day happen. A part of the entry is to volunteer for a job by writing your name on the whiteboard, it's ok to have lots doing one job, "many hands make light work!"

We are starting a little later in the morning on Saturday so it would be appreciated if you could arrive early and then help set up the equipment ready to start. Enjoy!!!!

How it Works

- 1) Point scores of all the events, Hack, Working Stock Horse and Utility Pattern, are added together and then the time from the Time Trial in seconds, is deducted.
- 2) Competitors start with the Hack, then when finished that go straight on to the Working Stock Horse, the Utility, then lastly the Time Trial. The first competitors in order will be Young Horse, then Encouragement, Junior, Youth, Maiden, and lastly Open.
- 3) Presentations will be at the clubhouse when everyone has finished and scores are compiled.
- 4) All riders please register at the office in the clubhouse in the morning from 7:30am, prior to the event and before riding. Here you will receive a warm welcome and instructions for the day. It is essential you put your name down for a job on the whiteboard to help with all those little jobs that need doing.
- 5) One of these important jobs is a "penciller" and "time keeper". It would be appreciated if you could volunteer someone to do that job. A jobs list is attached for that purpose. Maybe it is someone accompanying you over the weekend. Thank you.
- 6) This is a one-horse one-rider event. The exception is where an Open competitor can enter the Young Horse on a horse 4 years or under and then enter the Open on a different horse, an Open horse.
- 7) DEC ground fees are included in your entry. There is a charge for camping and extra horses.
- 8) The committee reserves the right to place your nomination in the category of challenge that they deem appropriate. All entries are accepted at the discretion of the committee. The committee will do their best to be fair to all and to encourage everyone to have a go and enjoy the event.

- 9) Please note that the Encouragement Challenge is for those who have NOT done a challenge before, or have limited experience at Stock Horse Events.
- 10) There is no catering so it is a BYO.
- 11) When packing up please ensure you clean your yards and surrounds of manure and rubbish.
- 12) Awards: There are ribbons to places 1-4 for each event, hack, WSH, Utility, Time Trial. There is a Hi-point award for every section (Young Horse, Encouragement, Junior, Youth, Maiden and Open) which is any breed and there will be an overall Hi-Point ASH award.
