All horse floats must enter through GATE 2

the entrance to this gate is off Stirling Terrace, over the bridge on the left.

Gates open from 6am on show day

One horse entry allows for 2 persons to enter the show grounds.

Any additional persons must pay the normal show entry rates at the gate.

PLEASE REPORT TO THE HORSE TENT WHEN YOU ARRIVE

so that we know you are at the show, can check and confirm your entries and we know we can expect you to attend the classes you have entered.

PARKING you must park as directed by the Parking Attendants otherwise you may be asked to leave the

show grounds There is limited parking space at the Toodyay Show Grounds and every effort is made to try and fit everyone comfortably in. Any persons disobeying the Parking Attendants instructions may be asked to leave the Show Grounds and will NOT be issued any refunds.

YARDS a limited number of yards are available on the grounds, yards are allocated on a first booked & paid for basis. A yard cleaning bond of \$20 must be paid along with entry fees. A refund of \$10 will be given if the yard is left clean and free from manure as checked by an Ag Society member when the exhibitor is leaving the grounds.

Refunds must be collected on the show day.

If you wish to use float yards you MUST park next to the cricket pitch area. Float Yards are NOT to be set up anywhere along the driveway / car park area. The driveway around the oval must be always kept clear for show traffic.

DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS

so please leave your dogs at home.

FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO ARE WONDERING WHAT YOU WILL HAVE TO DO IN THESE STRANGE NEW CLASSES??

These classes are all about you riding amongst obstacles that will require your horse to be brave whilst you and your horse are being judged like a normal ridden class. You may have to ride around cones with bali flags flapping away in them, or between cones with spinning flower windmills, or over a tarp in amongst the rubber ducky's. You will have to pick up and carry a teddy bear and take it for a ride with you. You will have to ride over some poles amongst some little trees. Lots of obstacles & "horsey toys" for your horse to have a look at. JUST HAVE A GO!

Your horse must be registered with the appropriate breed society to enter the appropriate breed group class. If your horse has multiple registrations you may enter all of those classes for which the horse holds a registration certificate.

This will be announced over the PA & All rings will stop to enable all eligible horses (anyone who has won Champion in their Breed Class) to compete in the Supreme class if your horse is eligible for supreme and you are in your ridden classes you do not have to untack your horse for the supreme run out unless you have time & wish to.

Once the Supreme Awards are finished all rings will recommence their scheduled classes.

You must enter the Best Presented Class for the same ring as your other breed classes are being held in:

OPEN BREED SHOW CLASSES

Ground Fee of \$10 per horse payable with entry fees.

LIMITED YARDS are available for \$20 day fee

(if cleaned & checked when you leave you will receive a \$10 refund)

COMPETITORS AGE is the riders age on the day of the show. All competitors under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by the Parent / Guardian as stated on the Minors Disclaimer Form.

COMPETITORS CLOTHING All riders must wear approved safety helmets and smooth soled riding boots. You may wear your Pony Club or Adult Riders Club Uniform.

COMPETITORS TACK All tack must be in a good and safe working condition and appropriate for the type of horse or pony.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES The Toodyay Ag Society reserves the right to refuse any exhibit entry without assigning a reason, if an exhibit entry is refused the exhibitor will be advised in writing (normally by email) and the Toodyay Ag Society's decision is final.

LATE ENTRIES will be accepted on the day with a late fee of \$20.

All competitors are expected to have read and understood the Rules & Regulations in conjunction with the Toodyay Agricultural Society Inc Regulations & By-laws.

CLASS & ENTRY RULES

LOCAL RIDER CLASSES A Local Rider is anyone living in the Shire of Toodyay or who is a member of Mortlock Pony Club or Avon Valley Adult Riders Club.

CLASSES MAY BE SPLIT OR JOINED depending on entry numbers and at the discretion of the Judge on the day.

Ag Society have made every effort to include a variety of events and multiple classes for exhibitors to enter and the timetable has been worked out to try and avoid any class times clashing, however if this does occur the exhibitor must choose which class they will attend and which class they will miss. CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP TO WAIT FOR EXHIBITORS IN OTHER RINGS unless the Judge of that ring decides to do so if there is time to do so. The Judges decision to wait or close the class is FINAL. NO REFUNDS will be given if you miss your class. CANCELLATIONS If any classes have to be cancelled you will be refunded the entry fee for the cancelled class only.

REFUNDS Entry fees will only be refunded (less a \$10 Admin Fee) if a written request is received and is accompanied by a Vet Certificate or Doctors Certificate dated within 7 days prior to the show.

HORSES AGE The horses age is taken from the 1st August each year. STALLIONS OR COLTS may only be ridden or handled by adults over the age of 18 years and must be handled in suitable head gear. By submitting your entry to this year's Toodyay Ag Show Equestrian Events you immediately and completely agree to the Conditions of Entry and all of the Rules & Regulations as stated on this program and the entry forms for this show.

RULES & REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITS & EXHIBITORS AT SHOW GROUNDS

A vet is present on the show grounds for the show day, if an exhibit becomes injured and the Ring Mistress determines that the exhibit requires veterinary care the Exhibitor MUST EITHER use the services of the vet on call at the show grounds OR immediately remove the exhibit from the show grounds and arrange for the exhibitors usual vet to attend to the horse.

ILL OR INJURED EXHIBITS Should the Toodyay Ag Society have any reason to suspect that an exhibit is ill or injured the Ring Mistress may insist that the exhibit is remove from the show grounds immediately.

DANGEROUS EXHIBITS

Should any exhibit display any dangerous behaviour anywhere on the show grounds the Toodyay Ag Society / Ring Mistress may insist the exhibit be removed from the showg rounds immediately.

INTOXICATED EXHIBITORS

Should any exhibitor display any intoxicated or drug affected behaviour they will be ordered to remove themselves from the show grounds immediately.

ACCIDENTS & INJURIES to any exhibitor, handler, attendee or exhibit.

The Toodyay Ag Society will not be held responsible for any accident that may be cause by any exhibitor and it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Toodyay Ag Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident or injury.

PROTESTS Judges are not to be approached by any exhibitor, all Judges decisions on the day are final. Any protest must be lodged within one hour of the class with a deposit of \$50 to the Ring Mistress at the Show Grounds before 5pm on Show Day. The deposit will be forfeited if the Toodyay Ag Society deem the protest to be unfounded or frivolous. Any prize money or prizes for the class in question may then be with held in consequence of the protest and be forfeited to the Toodyay Ag Society (the next place getter does not automatically become entitled to the prize) and the Toodyay Ag Society shall decide the final resolution

FRAUDULENT INFORMATION REGARDING EXHIBITS

Any exhibitor who provides an incorrect description, name, height, colour etc of their horse on their entry form in an attempt to exhibit a different horse than which is stated on the supplied copies of registration papers shall be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show and the particulars of the case shall be recorded in the proceedings of the Society.

Remember horses can not be left at the show grounds over night. FOOD AND DRINKS ARE AVAILABLE ALL DAY AT THE SHOW
