Event attendees: Preparation and requirements for HORSES and DONKEYS

Property Identification Code: PIC

- All owners of horses and donkeys must have a valid PIC for where their stock are kept.

Identification:

- Horses and donkeys must not leave the property without either a freeze or fire brand or Approved identification.

NOTE horses and donkeys do not need rebranding if ownership changes and the current owner has proof of ownership.

ID Exemptions: Approved identification systems are in place –

- **Horses** registered to **Australian Friesian Horse Society** can travel if identified with a DNA test and microchip.
- **Horses** registered to **Friesian Sporthorse Association** can travel if identified with a microchip.
- **Horses** registered to the **Shire Horse Society** can travel if identified with a sketch, DNA test and a microchip recorded in Central Animal Records (CAR) and the Society's database.
- **Horses** registered to the **Australian Warmblood Horse Association** can travel if identified with a DPIRD registered stock brand and/or a microchip recorded in the Association's database.
- **Horses** registered as **Standardbreds** with **Racing and Wagering WA** can travel with the Breed Society freeze brand, microchip and and may have DPIRD registered stock brand.
- **Horses** registered as **Thoroughbreds** with **Racing and Wagering WA** can travel with the DPIRD registered stock brand and microchip recorded by the Australian Stud Book and Registrar of Racehorses.
- A **horse** that is not registered with any breed society or equine association can be identified with a **microchip** if the current owner has the number registered to themselves with any of the five following commercial animal microchip databases. In WA, microchips must be inserted by a vet.
 - Australasian Animal Registry (AAR)
 - Central Animal Records (CAR)
 - Homesafe ID
 - Petsafe
 - Global Micro Animal Registry

Movement:

- Horses and donkeys are not required to have a waybill when they move off property.
- The event manager should have a system in place to record who brought horses / donkeys onsite and from where. They may request your PIC.

- ❖ Judging commences at 8:30am sharp. Classes will not be held up for any reason.
- ❖ **SOCIETY'S LIABILITY:** All persons entering the horse section do so at their own risk.
- ❖ **THE BRUNSWICK AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY AND STEWARDS HAVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY COMPETITOR WITHOUT GIVING REASON FOR DOING SO.**
- ❖ **All Entries** will be taken online via **NOMINATE**, see the Ag Show category.
- ❖ Entries close Monday 21st October 9pm.
- ❖ Each Class entry \$10 per class Ground Fee \$5 per Horse or Pony (only paid once if going between Breed and Showhorse or Show Jumping). **No Gate Entry fee**
- ❖ **All competitors must have a current PIC number. PIC numbers can be obtained via WA Ag Dept.**
- ❖ The Stewards and Judges may change the order of judging at their own discretion.
- ❖ **The trimming or clipping of all sensory hairs on all horses is prohibited, this is inline with FEI and EA rules and horse welfare.**
- ❖ **All competitors are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship, horsemanship and behaviour.** If judges or stewards witness any signs of abuse towards a horse or pony, fellow competitors, Stewards and Judges, the judge or steward may ask the exhibitor to leave the ring and all entry monies will be forfeited.
- ❖ **Any complaints are to be brought to the stewards tent.** This include issues regards horse welfare and competitor or spectators behaviour.
- ❖ All entries must be accompanied by photocopies of horse's registration and a current breed membership. All monies must be paid before judging starts.
- ❖ **Classes are entered per breed not per registration** eg a Welsh D can only enter APSB either under their Welsh or APSB registration/membership, they can not enter Any Other Registered Pony under the other registration.
- ❖ The **Any Other Registration sections** are only for horses and ponies that do not have their own breed on the list of breeds.
- ❖ **You are responsible for cleaning up after yourselves including horse manure around your float and on the main oval.** Please clean up after yourself and your horse Bins will be provided.
- ❖ **Stallions and Colts must be shown in suitable headgear** and handlers must be over 18 years unless specified by breed regulation.
- ❖ Stallions and Colts are to accompanied by a person over 18yo or locked in float/truck. **No exceptions.** We strongly advise that all stallions wear a **GREEN** disc and that all exhibitor be aware and respectful to the stallions on the grounds.
- ❖ **Exhibitors having a horse/s in more than one ring being judged simultaneously, must elect in which class they will compete.**
- ❖ No appeal against the decision of the judges will not be entertained unless made in writing and a fee of \$100.00 lodged. Appeal to be lodged within one hour of said event to the Steward's tent.
- ❖ **Please remember the Stewards and Pencillers are Volunteers,** it is your responsibility to know which classes you have entered and be ready to enter your class when called.
- ❖ **Ambulance will be visible on the oval, this is for the safety of all competitors.**
- ❖ **Winner of the Yearling classes are eligible to enter champion Colt or Filly or Gelding** eg If the winner of the yearling class is a filly, they may enter the Champion Filly or Mare. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be in the correct champion class.
