BROOKLEIGH ARC UNOFFICIAL SHOW HORSE & HUNTER - RULES

- Entry is by pre-entry only. Refunds will only be issued with a vet or doctor's certificate dated prior to or on the day of competition.
- The organising committee of Brookleigh Adult Riding Club, judges, and volunteers do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness, or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk, and a 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation.
- The Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter, or combine any event they deem necessary on the day. The Committee also reserves the right to interpret all rules and make a decision in any dispute.
- All riders are required to wear an approved, tagged helmet and riding boots as a condition of entry.
- Horses must be presented in a snaffle bridle and approved bit as outlined in the EA Show Horse Rules (www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA_NATIONAL_SHOW%20HORSE_RULES_CLEAN_JAN_2025.pdf) or approved bitless bridle (as outlined in the ARCA Manual & Gear Check Rules).
- No double bridles allowed.
- No martingales are allowed, and whips must not exceed 70cm in length.
- Stallions are not permitted on the grounds or to compete.
- Dogs are not permitted.
- Competitors and spectators must behave respectfully toward judges, officials, and fellow competitors.
- Bullying or unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and may result in warnings, class disqualification, or expulsion from the show.
- Riders and horse owners must ensure their horses' welfare is met, following the EA Code of Conduct at all times. Any undue distress to horses will be addressed by the Committee.
- The Committee reserves the right to expel any horse from the grounds if its behaviour is deemed unruly, unmanageable, or poses a safety risk.
- The judge's decision is final. Protests must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event, accompanied by a \$100 fee (refunded if the protest is upheld).
- Competitors cannot enter the ring once judging has commenced.
- Show attire preferred, and plaiting is optional.
- Horses and riders can only compete in one section-either Walk/Trot or Walk/Trot/Canter. Walk/Trot classes are for horses that have not competed in canter classes (including dressage or eventing). Riders competing in walk/trot who are seen cantering in warm up will be asked to move to the walk/trot/canter section.
- Rider's age will be determined as of the day of the event.
- Horse/Pony and Rider combinations that have competed in an official ring in the past 12 months are not eligible to compete.
- This event is open to unofficial horses only.
- No height certificates are required for entry.
- Boots, bandages and ear bonnets are not allowed in this competition.
- Hoof paint and quarter markers are allowed.
- All manure and hay must be removed from arenas, yards, float areas or other areas used, before leaving.
- Competitors competing in OTTWA classes must provide a copy of their OTTWA Passport and provide Horse ID Number with entry.
